



Palestine Revolution Command to be set up

CAIRO, March 7: A General Command of the Palestine Revolution, will be set up and its constitution published in a week, 'Al-Ahram' reported today.

The command will be composed of the Palestine (PLA) Liberation Army, the military wing of the Palestine Liberation Organisation (PLO) and "elements of popular militia".

Only one spokesman would be authorised to speak for the Palestinian Revolution and, Al-Ahram added, only five organisations would be permitted to continue their activities.

61 election deaths in India

NEW DELHI, March 7: A brawl over the identity of a woman voter added two more deaths to the 10-day poll ended.

Police reported five other deaths in the country, bringing the total number of dead to 61 since the elections began on October 25. The deaths were reported from Uttar Pradesh, Bihar, West Bengal, Madhya Pradesh and Kerala.

COPENHAGEN, March 7: Israel is willing to negotiate with the UAR on all outstanding questions, Israel's Foreign Minister Abba Eban told Copenhagen newspaper, 'Berlingske Tidende', in an interview published today.

ARRIVAL IN Dacca

"By this time, our Parliamentary Party had assembled at Dacca and Members had already begun to discuss the political situation in the Western Wing."

CONSPIRATORIAL FORCES

"Indeed, we had warned in our statement that the dark conspiratorial forces had always intervened in our country whenever the people were to take the initiative through the democratic process. The microscopic minority, which represented the interests of the Western Wing, had by sabotaging democracy deprived the 75 million oppressed masses of the Western Wing of their basic rights in 1953. The then Prime Minister was dismissed by a conspiracy of the Punjabi ruling class in 1957. The Government in East Bengal was dismissed and the Constituent Assembly itself was dismissed by the same clique. When general elections were to be held in early 1959, the vested interests of the ruling class again struck and usurped power. Today, the Punjabi ruling class has again tried to repeat this disgraceful history. But they should know that the awakened masses of Bengal Desh, as also the oppressed masses of the Western Wing, shall resist their foul conspiracies by every means possible."
